

**CITY OF BUENA PARK
CULTURAL & FINE ARTS COMMISSION
April 18, 2018**

CALL TO ORDER: Chair Aceves called the Cultural & Fine Arts Commission to order at 7:00 p.m., City Hall Main Conference Room, 6650 Beach Boulevard, Buena Park, California.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: The pledge of allegiance was led by Vice Chair Patterson.

1. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES: March 6, 2018** - Special Meeting for Commissioner Training - ***M/S/P Commissioners Hurtado/Kim approved the minutes as presented.
2. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Meeting of March 21, 2018** - ***M/S/P - Vice Chair Patterson requested the minutes be corrected to reflect under Item 8 - Commissioner Reports as follows: Vice Chair Patterson attended the commissioner training as well as the High School Art Show awards ceremony and was impressed. Commissioner Hurtado/Vice Chair Patterson approved the minutes as corrected.
3. **PUBLIC COMMENT:** None.
4. **DIRECTOR'S/STAFF REPORT:** Margaret Riley, Director of Community Services announced Love Buena Park on Saturday, April 28, 2018, 7:30 a.m. at The Source. Anyone interested in volunteering for the event is asked to sign up directly through the website at www.lovebuenapark.com or they may also go directly to the event.
5. **CITY UPDATES:** Ms. Riley announced the groundbreaking of Hotel Stanford located at 7860 Beach Blvd. on Monday, April 23, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. This hotel will be next to the former Ripley's Believe It or Not site and will consist of a 10-story, 150-room, five-level parking structure and a rooftop restaurant and bar.

Additionally, Ms. Riley announced the City Clerk's office now offers passport services by appointment only from 9:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday and alternating Fridays.

6. DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS:

- a. Discussion and Direction on Music Education Program (Park) - Commissioner Park was not present for the report. Vice Chair Patterson made a motion to table this item for

discussion to the next meeting in May. Commissioner Kim seconded. Hearing no further discussion, the motion carried.

- b. High School Art Show Evaluation (Staff) - Maya Mackrandilal, Community Services Coordinator provided a brief presentation on the success of the show. There were a total of 110 participants. Students can enter in three categories however, can only win in one category. The prizes were as follows: 1st Place - \$75; 2nd Place - \$50; 3rd Place - \$25. There was also a category for Honorable Mention. All the participants received a certificate and medal.
- c. Summer Concerts Lineup Confirmation (Staff) - Imani Tolliver, Community Services Supervisor announced the lineup as follows:

- d. Future Participation in Black History Parade (Staff) - Ms. Riley reported that the city has participated in the parade for the past two years. The total cost to participate is \$785.00. City Council is seeking recommendations from the commission on whether or not participation in the parade should continue. After discussion, Commissioner Kim made a motion to continue participating in the parade but discontinue the cost of maintaining a booth. Chair Aceves made a subsequent motion to participate in the parade and direct efforts toward bringing something to Buena Park instead. Hearing no second, the motion died. Commissioner Kim re-stated his motion to continue participating in the parade but discontinue efforts of maintaining a booth at the parade. Commissioner Hurtado seconded. Hearing no further discussion, the motion carried.
- e. Fine Arts Cultural Event Ad Hoc Committee Update (Patterson) - Vice Chair Patterson provided a brief update to the ad hoc committee meeting that took place on March 24, 2018. They discussed ways to better serve the community's diversity and possible dates to host the event. The committee is also waiting to hear back from The Source to further discuss using The Source as a possible venue. This one-day cultural event would be celebrated with art, food and a concert.
- f. Enterprise Account (Staff) - Ms. Tolliver reported the beginning balance was \$4,394.36 less \$676.77 which includes payment for the Black History Parade table snacks, Art Festival craft supplies as well for the Art Festival Drummer plus a donation in the amount of \$315.00. The ending balance was \$4,032.59.

Further, Commissioner Kim requested a list of general items purchased for the Art Festival. He will forward that list to Wal Mart to request a donation of supplies.

Vice Chair Patterson also attended the Elementary Art Show awards ceremony and had a great time. The artwork from the students were amazing. Chair Aceves also attended the High School and Elementary Art Show awards ceremonies and agrees that it was a very rewarding experience.
10. **COMMISSIONER COMMENTS/ FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS:** Commissioner Clarke announced that she plans on attending a food truck event to seek possibilities for having them at various Cultural and Fine Arts events. She added that she would like to see more participation from local Buena Park schools in the Elementary Art Show. Commissioner Kim praised staff for all their work. Chair Aceves thanked staff for all they do and looks forward to Council's recommendations in regards to the Black History Parade. He would like to see something that represents the city.
