- 5. While the Navigation Center is not a drug or alcohol rehab facility, what has their process been when faced with a client with a substance use (SU) issue? Do they simply exit them to the street or connect to specific SU resources or other service provider?
- 6. What are the type of donations the Navigation Center has received? What is useful and what is not?

- 7. Has the Navigation Center collaborated with any local Buena Park business to attempt a jobs/vocational type training program for clients that may qualify?
- 8. Has the Navigation Center reached out to the local Buena Park carpenters Union for any potential training scholarships (or the like) for those clients that may qualify?
