OLD BUSINESS: (1- 4)

1. EDCO Earth Day Event – Saturday, May 22

Doug Brodowski reported that EDCO would like to partner with the City and the BE Commission to host an Earth Day recycling event. The event will include electronics disposal, paper shredding and free mulch. Unfortunately, staff was unable to secure the date with Knott's Berry Farm. Brodowski will notify the Commission once a date and location has been scheduled.

2. Neighborhood Improvement Partnership Program (NIPP Spring) Update

Doug Brodowski reported that the next street slurry project is scheduled to begin in the residential tract behind city hall sometime in May; this will be a good location for the Spring NIPP. The Commission chose Saturday, June 12 as a tentative date for the NIPP. He will report back to the Commission at the next meeting. Commissioner Rollins submitted photos of overgrown shrubs from private property that has grown over onto the SCE right of way. The Commission will consider this as a possible NIPP.

3. BP Community CleanUp Program Update

Doug Brodowski reported he will meet with the City Manager regarding the BP Community CleanUp for discussion at City Council study session before moving forward with this program.

4. BEC Mascot/Logo for Keep Green/Clean Ads

Commissioner Rollins submitted artwork for the BEC mascot/logo idea. Chair McKinney suggested that “Keep Green/Clean” signs could be posted on the parkway in front of apartment complexes or areas that are high litter areas. The sign could remind people of illegal dumping.
