CALL TO ORDER: Chair Rollins called the Fine Arts Commission to order at 7:00 p.m., City Council Chambers, 6650 Beach Boulevard, Buena Park, California.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: The pledge of allegiance was led by Commissioner Pitts.

1. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Meeting of October 15, 2014.
M/S/P – Commissioners McGuire/Mahaffey – Motion to approve minutes as presented.
2. **PUBLIC COMMENT:** None.
3. **DIRECTOR/STAFF REPORT:** Margaret Riley, Director of Community Services, announced the City Council election results. Councilmembers Swift and Berry were re-elected; new Council Member, Virginia Vaughn was elected into office . Council Member Art Brown is the new Mayor; Mayor Pro Tem is Fred Smith.
4. **DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS:**
 - a. Civic Theatre - Play Selection - Commissioner McGuire announced that the sub-committee did not meet therefore there is no play selection for the commission to vote. This item has been tabled to the next commission meeting for further discussion.
 - b. Youth Theatre - Play Selection - Commissioner Labok announced the choices for 2015 are as follows: Les Miserables - school edition; Cinderella; Sound of Music; or Miracle on 34th Street. Commissioner Donnelly made a motion to accept the 2015 choices as presented. Commissioner Pitts seconded. All were in favor except for Commissioner McGuire, who opposed the motion.
 - c. Youth Programs Elementary School Art Show Theme and Promotion - Commissioner Mulligan announced the theme for the art show is, "My Life in the Wild". Commissioner McGuire made a motion to accept the theme, "My Life in the Wild" for the Elementary Art Show.
M/S/P - Commissioners McGuire/Labok approved the theme, "My Life in the Wild" for the Elementary Art Show.

- d. **2014 Holiday Celebration - Discussion** - After discussion, the commission decided the location will be at the Buena Park Community Center ballroom with a potluck style dinner. The commissioners, their spouses and City Council are invited. Commissioner Mulligan made a motion to have the holiday celebration at the Community Center with a potluck style dinner or an affordable food vendor, if available. All were in favor.

- e. **Enterprise Account - Statement** was not available at the time of the report. Chair Rollins noted that there has not been any changes since the last reporting period.

5. STANDING COMMITTEE REPORT:

- a. **Civic Theatre / McGuire** - Commissioner McGuire reported that the sub-committee met. They will be meeting again soon to further discuss options for a larger production.
- b. **Community Service Recognition** - Commissioner Mahaffey reminded the commission to start thinking of names of volunteers they would like to see recognized.
- c. **Excursions / Banados** - Commissioner Banados was not present for the report. Commissioner Mulligan volunteered to be the host of the Rose Parade excursion if Commissioner Banados is not available.
- d. **Exhibiting Artist** - Chair Rollins announced that the current art on display is a group exhibition from the Buena Park Senior Activity Center.
- e. **Jazz Festival / Pitts** - Commissioner Pitts announced that the sub-committee has not met. A meeting will be scheduled sometime in February 2015.
- f. **Summer Concerts / Mulligan** - Commissioner Mulligan reported that the sub-committee agreed to book the popular bands for 2015 as soon as possible such as Stone Soul, Britain's Finest, Wise Guys, and Mariachi Del Sol de San Fernando. The sub-committee is exploring new genres as well. They will be meeting in December to further discuss more options.
- g. **Youth Theatre / Labok** - Commissioner Labok reported on All Shook Up. The performance dates are November 21-23 & November 28-30, 2014. All are encouraged to attend.
- h. **Youth Programs / Mulligan** - Commissioner Mulligan reported on the Elementary Art Show which will be on display in the Council Chamber from January 6 - 29, 2015. The Theme is "My Life in the Wild". This will be followed by the High School Art Show which will be on display from February 3 - 27, 2015. The Children's Art Festival will be held on April 25, 2015 at the Buena Park Community Center.

- a. Hospitality – Chair Rollins noted that she will send a nice plant and get-well card on behalf of the commission to Tommy Walp, Commissioner Ruth Walp's husband.


