CALL TO ORDER: Chair Rollins called the Fine Arts Commission to order at 7:00 p.m., City Council Chambers, 6650 Beach Boulevard, Buena Park, California.

1. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Meeting of March 18, 2015.

3. **DIRECTOR/STAFF REPORT:** Imani Tolliver, Community Services Supervisor reported on behalf of Margaret Riley, Director of Community Services.
