Purpose: To extend the current interim urgency ordinance prohibiting all commercial medical marijuana uses, including delivery, storage, and commercial and non-commercial cultivation.

Recommended Action: 1) Adopt an interim urgency ordinance extending the current interim urgency ordinance prohibiting all commercial medical marijuana uses, including delivery, storage, and commercial and non-commercial cultivation until November 23, 2016, pursuant to California Government Code 65858.
